In 1999, the Student Employee of the Year Award was established by the National Student Employment Association to encourage higher education colleges and universities to honor outstanding student employees for academic and employment excellence. This year marks the 16th Annual Student Employee of the Year Award Ceremony. Currently, the Student Employment Office and Scholarships & Financial Aid present this award to two recipients, one employed on-campus and one employed off-campus for their contributions to Texas A&M University and the surrounding community.

Class of 1956 Student Employee Endowed Award

In 2006, on the occasion of their fiftieth anniversary, the Texas A&M Class of 1956 established the Class of 1956 Student Employee Endowed Award. The 1956 class members wanted to establish a gift that would be significant, unique, and support students working through college. To be considered for the Class of '56 Student Employee Endowed Award, students must be nominated by their supervisors, be working part-time, and their employment must be processed through one of the Texas A&M University System payroll stations.




